About Your Skin Check

All the practitioners at Qutis Skin Check Clinic are fully qualified and registered General Practitioners with additional qualifications in Skin Cancer Medicine.

At your initial appointment, your doctor will assess your skin cancer risk based on your skin type, general medical history, including any medication you are taking and your family history.

Each visit you will receive a comprehensive full body skin check where your doctor performs a thorough examination of your skin from your scalp right down to between your toes! Our practitioners are well trained in Skin Cancer medicine, so a comprehensive full body skin check only takes about fifteen minutes!

If a suspicious lesion is found, your doctor will either take a photo and organise a review or perform a biopsy to be sent for pathology testing and advise you of the results.
